In addition officers were elected and your 2011 / 2012 officers will be:

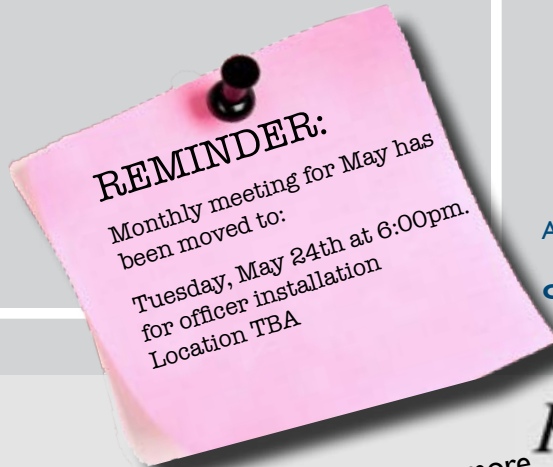

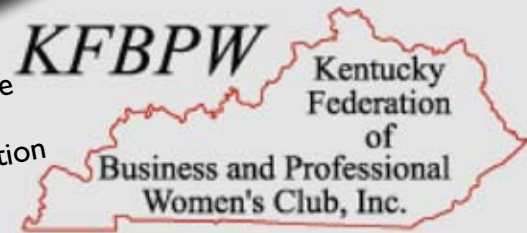
